The Second World War Tribute was introduced in September 2014 to mark the 75th anniversary of the beginning of the Second World War.

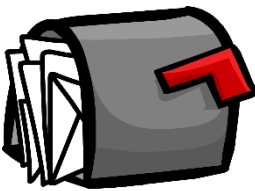
WHICH BENEFITS ARE YOU ELIGIBLE FOR?
